As soon as they rounded the Cape, the Bounty hit howling head winds and massive waves (the biggest Bligh had ever encountered, he recorded) and the crew spent the next 33 days urging their ship to make forward progress. After 'round the clock shifts, rigging the ship to tack forward into an unrelenting gale force roar of freezing wind and waves and continually shovelling snow from

the frozen deck, Bligh calculated they had in fact had been blown backwards, and actually lost progress in their voyage.

He wisely ordered the ship to be turned around and to make passage around the Horn of Africa instead. The longer route, but now sailing with the wind. The exhausted crew were jubilant.

All through June and July, we at TUC are attempting to lean into the wind of the Spirit. If you have ever been sailing, you will know that moment when the wind gust fills the sail, the boat shudders and tilts, and the resulting energy powers the vessel along. The crew have to either work with the breeze or be buffeted by it. We want to be blown by the Spirit in the direction God is calling us to. There is a strong sense the wind is blowing, and we are blessed to have people attuned to listen and be obedient to the Holy Spirit's leading. Surely God has wonderful plans and purposes for us, still all sinners and broken, yet called by Jesus to serve in God's redemptive plan of reconciliation for the whole world.

That's a big vision, and only possible by harnessing the unlimited power of God's Spirit, that was promised to us to fulfil this goal. No, we can't do it in our power, or we will soon become completely exhausted. God's plan is far too big for our own efforts. But can you feel that breeze? So climb aboard, grab a rope and Heave Away! and allow the Spirit to empower us, in the direction He wants, to the total glory of Jesus in this community.

Children's & Youth Ministry

KATS (Toddlers - Year 5)

KATS stands for Kids at Toowong on Sunday and is our Sunday morning children's program run during the school term. The children leave after the children's talk to gather in their **Tiger, Leopard and Lion age groups.** An enthusiastic group of volunteers lead these groups, teaching the children about God in a fun and friendly environment.

Junior Youth (years 6 - 8)

Junior Youth also gather on Sunday mornings after the children's talk in the church house for a time of bible study and fun activities. The Scripture Union Light curriculum is used for KATS and Junior Youth. Each session encourages the children to get to know God better through praying together, looking at the bible together and themed games and craft.

Senior Youth (years 9 - 12)

Senior Youth join in with the whole Sunday worship and are encouraged to take on leadership roles in the church. Senior Youth also meet together every second Saturday night during the school term for Youth Group. Our remaining dates for Senior Youth in term 2 are: 11 May, 25 May, 8 June and 22 June.
