

Welcome!

To prevent this theme for August - 'More Like Jesus' - guilting us into weary effort, leaving us hopelessly disappointed in ourselves, and stranded in the realms of impossible standards, what if we gave up trying to become a saint? What if the invitation was to simply be ourselves in Jesus' company, and see what happens over the course of a good dinner? Think about the changes that happened to Zacchaeus over a delicious meal.

When thinking about a life in Christ, the analogy of pickling cucumbers might give hope. The moment the cucumbers are immersed in the pickle juice, a war immediately begins between the 'good' bacteria that provides the flavour and zest, and 'bad' bacteria that threatens to break down and decompose the cucumber. If the liquid environment of the catalysing agents is just



Cucumbers and Christians share that process of immersion and conversion. And while there seems to be little change physically to both on the surface, the proof of the change is obvious on the inside. All through August, we're cheering each other on to become more like Jesus.

A friend recalls the time he was a support van driver for a team of endurance runners that covered hundreds of kilometres over a period of days. What inspired him above all was the enthusiastic, over-the-top encouragement that all teams gave to all competitors in a spirit of mutual caring. Everyone knew precisely what the other runners were going through, committed to the same experience. The cheering was continuous, the affection was genuine, especially with support runners who accompanied the 'rear guard', to urge them on and not give up. My friend came back from that experience thinking "Could my church life be as encouraging as this marathon weekend?".

In our marathon, its not about winners and losers, it is about the one who went before us and showed us the way. Cheer each other on – and "be confident of this very thing, that he who has begun a good work in you, will perform it until the day of Jesus Christ." (Philippians 1: 6)

An eight week journey through the Lord's Prayer

We are really excited to be starting The Prayer Course at TUC! This eight week course is run by the 24-7 Prayer group, and you can find all the resources you will need to run the course in your small group on the website above.

That's right, instead of just running this course from one location at TUC, we are asking you to start up small groups in your homes and lead the course yourselves. We think this will be a great opportunity to all be working through this course together as we grow deeper in our praying relationship with God and strengthen relationships with one another.

Here's what to do:

1. Let us know if you would like to lead a small group.

- You can invite whoever you like to your group, and keep it as big or small as you like.
 Why not even invite friends and family from outside TUC to come along?
- You can choose when you meet with your group over the 8 weeks e.g. maybe every Sunday afternoon, or maybe on a weeknight, whatever suits you and your group best.
- You could choose to meet always in your home, or in a different home each time. You
 could also run each week's session on Zoom.
- Each session goes for an hour, and the website has all the videos, discussion questions and ideas for how to run each session just follow along.

Children's & Youth Ministry

KATS (Toddlers - Year 5)

KATS stands for Kids at Toowong on Sunday and is our Sunday morning children's program run during the school term. The children leave after the children's talk to gather in their **Tiger, Leopard and Lion age groups.** An enthusiastic group of volunteers lead these groups, teaching the children about God in a fun and friendly environment.

Junior Youth (years 6 - 8)

Junior Youth also gather on Sunday mornings after the children's talk for a time of bible study and fun activities. The Scripture Union Light curriculum is used for KATS and Junior Youth. Each session encourages the children to get to know God better through praying together, looking at the bible together and themed games and craft.

Senior Youth (years 9 - 12)

Senior Youth join in with the whole Sunday worship and are encouraged to take on leadership roles in the church. Senior Youth also meet together every second Friday night during the school term for Youth Group.

Children's & Youth Events

A number of events are run during the year, such as the Junior Youth Sleepover, the Moonwalk and the Light Party. Keep checking the newsletter and enews for updates about these events.

Safe Ministry with Children

TUC has adopted the Uniting Church in Australia Queensland Synod's Safe Ministry with Children policy and believes that every person is precious to God and in following Jesus' example, we are committed to providing a safe church for all, particularly those who are vulnerable.

All volunteers working with children at TUC have up-todate Blue Cards and have completed the Safe Ministry with Children training.

KATS & Junior Youth Dates

Due to Covid restrictions, we will run KATS and Junior Youth on alternate Sundays in the hall during the school terms. The children will take part in the first part of the service upstairs, which will include a Kids' Talk, before heading downstairs to the hall for KATS or Junior Youth.

Every week, Mandy runs Breakfast Club for the students before school so they can have a meal and spend some time with one another.


