Why our values matter

I'm sure many of us have had that joyful experience in the workplace where a huge amount of time and effort goes into establishing a lovely, warm, encouraging vision and values statement that then gets put on the shelf and largely ignored until the next time around. No? Just me?

It seems to me that the thing about working to agree on values is that it is actually up to all of us – you and me – how useful those values then become in our shared life. We – you and me – get to decide and determine what kind of church Toowong Uniting becomes, not only by agreeing with a set of values ora vision statement but by the ways we behave, and live and love God, one another, and our neighbours, the ways we put those values into practice.

The five values we've agreed on – **Prayer, Word and Worship, Equipping, Community, Sharing** – seem to me to be right on the money. Partly because what they really do is remind us of what we already know deep down are important to a healthy church. That reminder is helpful. It holds up in front of us what we already know – and reminds us of the importance of living up to them.

A healthy church, just like a healthy disciple is one grounded in prayer.

Prayer that contains all the elements Rob's LEGO video reminded us of a few weeks ago – praise, repentance, asking, and yielding to God's will and way. Pray early, and pray often!

A healthy church, just like a healthy disciple is one that lives deeply in Christ the Word of God, and in scripture; and is nourished and committed to a shared life of worship. Word and worship supports, enables, encourages us. A healthy church, just like a healthy disciple, is committed to ongoing learning, development and growth. We're always working to become more like Jesus, and to live out that Jesus-ness in our daily lives. This is the essence of equipping – more like Jesus, more of the time.

A healthy church, just like a healthy disciple takes seriously Jesus' commandment to love our

neighbours. Our neighbours, those we encounter, those we live among, those we share our lives with, form our community. And in turn we form that community in the ways we love our neighbours.

And a healthy church, just like a healthy disciple, works to share.

To share good news of God's love, to share the blessings with which we are gifted, to share love. Everything we have is for sharing – truth, food, resources, Spiritual gifts.

These values, these things we have together determined are important to us, and that we want to be reminded of, these can and should be the markers of our individual lives, and our shared life. Imagine Toowong as a church which we together determine to be one that is characterised by these five things – prayer, word and worship, equipping, community and sharing. That's a church I want to be part of!

Children's & Youth Ministry

KATS (Toddlers - Year 5)

KATS stands for Kids at Toowong on Sunday and is our Sunday morning children's program run during the school term. The children leave after the children's talk to gather in their **Tiger, Leopard and Lion age groups.** An enthusiastic group of volunteers lead these groups, teaching the children about God in a fun and friendly environment.

Junior Youth (years 6 - 8)

Junior Youth also gather on Sunday mornings after the children's talk for a time of bible study and fun activities. The Scripture Union Light curriculum is used for KATS and Junior Youth. Each session encourages the children to get to know God better through praying together, looking at the bible together and themed games and craft.

Senior Youth (years 9 - 12)

Senior Youth join in with the whole Sunday worship and are encouraged to take on leadership roles in the church. Senior Youth also meet together every second Friday night during the school term for Youth Group.

Children's & Youth Events

A number of events are run during the year, such as the Junior Youth Sleepover, the Moonwalk and the Light Party. Keep checking the newsletter and enews for updates about these events.

Safe Ministry with Children

TUC has adopted the Uniting Church in Australia Queensland Synod's Safe Ministry with Children policy and believes that every person is precious to God and in following Jesus' example, we are committed to providing a safe church for all, particularly those who are vulnerable.

All volunteers working with children at TUC have up-todate Blue Cards and have completed the Safe Ministry with Children training.

KATS & Junior Youth Dates

Due to Covid restrictions, we will run KATS and Junior Youth on alternate Sundays in the hall during the school terms. The children will take part in the first part of the service upstairs, which will include a Kids' Talk, before heading downstairs to the hall for KATS or Junior Youth.

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
Mt Coot-tha Walk for Chaplaincy
