Lauren was asked to create March's newsletter cover to capture this aspect of a promise, which she beautifully has and explains here:

"In Genesis 3 we read of the effects of sin on all of humanity and creation. Because of sin, all relationships are torn apart; that between the man and woman, and even the relationship between humankind and the earth. Genesis 3:14-20 presents a picture of tumult and brokenness. No longer would the man and woman live in harmony with one another and with the natural world. But, ever since the entrance of sin into the world, God has promised to not leave us stuck in this existence. Time and again, God takes action in His world to bring order to chaos and to eliminate sin, ultimately by sending Christ to die on the cross for us. In the image for this month, we see the fragmented parts of our created world being brought back together - the chaotic ocean has been stilled and is in harmony with the other elements. We can also see palm branches, a nod to our upcoming celebration of Palm Sunday and the saving action of Christ our King."

I've been greatly encouraged reading the covenantal promises from God, that we can live in, and look forward to sharing these with you. As we prepare for Good Friday and Resurrection Sunday, we can live in the promises that are there to be received, promises that come from the centre of God's heart. And that makes all the difference in life to know that which God has promised, God will surely fulfill.

As we travel to the cross together, may we be sustained by hope in the promises of Jesus our Lord.

### Children's & Youth Ministry

### KATS (Toddlers - Year 5)

KATS stands for Kids at Toowong on Sunday and is our Sunday morning children's program run during the school term. The children leave after the children's talk to gather in their **Tiger, Leopard and Lion age groups.** An enthusiastic group of volunteers lead these groups, teaching the children about God in a fun and friendly environment.

### Junior Youth (years 6 - 8)

Junior Youth also gather on Sunday mornings after the children's talk for a time of bible study and fun activities. The Scripture Union Light curriculum is used for KATS and Junior Youth. Each session encourages the children to get to know God better through praying together, looking at the bible together and themed games and craft.

### Senior Youth (years 9 - 12)

Senior Youth join in with the whole Sunday worship and are encouraged to take on leadership roles in the church. Senior Youth also meet together every second Friday night during the school term for Youth Group.

### **Children's & Youth Events**

A number of events are run during the year, such as the Junior Youth Sleepover, the Moonwalk and the Light Party. Keep checking the newsletter and enews for updates about these events.

### Safe Ministry with Children

TUC has adopted the Uniting Church in Australia Queensland Synod's Safe Ministry with Children policy and believes that every person is precious to God and in following Jesus' example, we are committed to providing a safe church for all, particularly those who are vulnerable.

All volunteers working with children at TUC have up-todate Blue Cards and have completed the Safe Ministry with Children training.

### KATS & Junior Youth Dates

Due to Covid restrictions, we will run KATS and Junior Youth on alternate Sundays in the hall during the school terms. The children will take part in the first part of the service upstairs, which will include a Kid's Talk, before heading downstairs to the hall for KATS or Junior Youth.
