Welcome!

As we approach Pentecost, the 'birthday of the Church', we remember how a small gathering of Jesus' followers were drenched with the Spirit 50 days after his resurrection. Filled with the Spirit, these first disciples spilled out into the streets and were empowered to proclaim the best news they had ever heard; that Jesus was risen and is Lord, and the Spirit's powerful presence testified to this truth.

Receive is our theme for May, with our focus on Jesus' invitation to 'Receive the Holy Spirit' (John 20: 22). When we do, the infinite power of the greatest Love and Truth becomes intravenous, we are vitally connected in a way we can't explain, but life in the Spirit is often beyond our own understanding!

Recently I have been often encouraged by dipping into Geoff Waugh's book "Flashpoints of Revival" to read the experiences

of Christians over the last 300 years, in diverse countries and cultures, reporting very similar experiences of the Holy Spirit breaking into their lives. Their accounts include testimony of dramatic healings, outpourings of grace and forgiveness and a discovery of an ardent love for Jesus. These accounts are well attested and researched, and all reveal how the Spirit will move where the Spirit wants to. These movements are powerful and unexpected. However, common to all these accounts is an absolute willingness from people and the Church to receive this anointing that God desires to impart.

As we approach Pentecost, can we please make that time – as I know you do – to prayerfully intercede for our Church and our community, that there will be a wonderful anointing of God's Spirit on us, and through the ministry of the Spirit, we will be able to share the gifts of grace we have received in extraordinary ways – with each other and our neighbourhood.

"Remember, I am with you always, even to the end of the age!"

Children's & Youth Ministry

KATS (Toddlers - Year 5)

KATS stands for Kids at Toowong on Sunday and is our Sunday morning children's program run during the school term. The children leave after the children's talk to gather in their **Tiger, Leopard and Lion age groups.** An enthusiastic group of volunteers lead these groups, teaching the children about God in a fun and friendly environment.

Junior Youth (years 6 - 8)

Junior Youth also gather on Sunday mornings after the children's talk for a time of bible study and fun activities. The Scripture Union Light curriculum is used for KATS and Junior Youth. Each session encourages the children to get to know God better through praying together, looking at the bible together and themed games and craft.

Senior Youth (years 9 - 12)

Senior Youth join in with the whole Sunday worship and are encouraged to take on leadership roles in the church. Senior Youth also meet together every second Friday night during the school term for Youth Group.

Children's & Youth Events

A number of events are run during the year, such as the Junior Youth Sleepover, the Moonwalk and the Light Party. Keep checking the newsletter and enews for updates about these events.
