## Minister's Welcome April 2022

Whenever April arrives, we know the humid weather is leaving and outdoor life and being in the garden becomes far more enticing.

The theme for this month is "**Tree of Life**", a resplendent Biblical image which sprung from the Tuesday night studies Ross Homel is leading (thanks Ross!). As you may recall, when God creates Eden, he places a Tree of Life in the centre of the garden. Initially, this tree could be eaten freely by the man and woman, yet it was closed off to them when they were forced to leave Eden. The tree reappears in John's Revelation, where it produces fruit that heals the nations in the City of God. It's a vibrant image of the way God uses His creation to bring renewal and vitality to our physical bodies, and just as much to our

souls. Between those two trees stands the cross, that re-unites us with the Edenic life which we all yearn for, to walk freely with God in the garden. While the cross is the symbol of ultimate sacrifice, the tree of Life is the symbol of everlasting gift. Both trees are reuniting us to God forever.

The oldest known living organism in the universe is a tree. The Bristlecone Pine in California is 4,862 years old! Think about that for a moment, the oldest living thing in the universe. Trees are symbolic for each of us – being connected to a place and time, digging deep, branching out, bearing fruit, sharing their abundance. We are encouraged to be the 'trees of righteousness, the planting of the Lord, so that God might be glorified" (Isaiah 61). Our lives are meant to bring spaciousness and restoration to all around us. Often when we look at trees, we might also appreciate their beauty. Some forest giants can inspire a response of praise to God.

Perhaps you can find some time over Easter to spend relaxing under a tree, enjoying the tranquillity and imagine how you are called to be 'a planting of the Lord'. In Him, we can bear much fruit.

P.S. If you want to know anything about trees, do ask Clare Hankamer whose doctoral studies were in the field of botany. Clare's former career saw her employed at Royal Botanic Gardens in Kew.

#### For Parents

#### KATS (Toddlers - Grade 5)

KATS stands for Kids at Toowong on Sunday and is our Sunday morning children's program run during the school term. The children leave after the children's talk to gather in their **Leopard and Lion age groups.** An enthusiastic group of volunteers lead these groups, teaching the children about God in a fun and friendly environment. The Scripture Union Light curriculum is used for KATS.

#### KATS will meet every Sunday in 2022.

#### Youth (Grades 6 - 12)

This year we are launching a new look youth group which will combine Junior and Senior Youth Groups and will meet every second Friday night in the Hall. We pray that it will be a great evening to hang out with friends and to spend some time asking the big questions of life and to pray and worship together.

We really love seeing our young people take part in worship on Sundays. We seek to support and encourage them to discover their leadership gifts and to be looking at ways to serve God in the Church and Community.

 $\checkmark$  children's faces will be blurred out on streaming or cameras would be turned off during Kid's Talks on Sundays.


