

"Smooth seas never made a skilled sailor."

Welcome! Our theme for March is "Challenge", which is the next step of lived - out hope, to keep persisting under difficult or even adverse conditions. Recent flooding of Brisbane has affected many of you, with major impacts to your homes and lives, or your neighbours. You are in the midst of managing significant upheaval, or assisting others who have been inundated, and our hearts and prayers are with you. Challenging times are asking questions of us, how do we respond?

Here's an example of an ad placed in a London newspaper by Ernest Shackleton in the early 1900s:

"Men wanted for hazardous journey. Low wages, bitter cold, long hours of complete darkness. Safe return doubtful. Honour and recognition in event of success."

Shackleton received hundreds of applications! People were eager to face a challenge that would threaten their lives, when they believed the goal was worth pursuing (to reach the South Pole).

Considering your own experience, it's likely proved there's no avoiding a range of challenges if we follow Jesus in our lives. True Christianity is no easy sell. We do not call people only to a crown but first to a cross. Anyone who promises smooth seas and plain sailing hasn't read the Gospels. We are inseparably bound to Jesus, we are part of the Body of Christ, so we share in his sufferings. Yet our participation in trials and difficulties – as Paul found – also allows us to share in the abundant encouragement and comfort that our Saviour provides. "For just as the sufferings of Christ flow over into our lives, so also, through Christ, our comfort flows" (2 Corinthians 1: 5)

As we go through this next phase of challenge in our city, reach out to assist and encourage those around you in need, with the very real encouragement of the Holy Spirit within you – providing you with the comfort, hope and endurance to face whatever may be before you. Please do reach out to your church for any assistance you require, we are eager to help.

75% 'Often' feel their gifts and talents are used in this congregation










65% believe that our congregation has a strong sense of mission and purpose








More than half responded that TUC provides opportunities to engage the local community



82% believe individual & small group prayers are an important part of TUC





As a parent, I go back to this verse in Isaiah again and again for encouragement:

He tends his flock like a shepherd:
He gathers the lambs in his arms
and carries them close to his heart;
he gently leads those that have young. (Isaiah 40:11)

KATS (Toddlers - Grade 5)

KATS stands for Kids at Toowong on Sunday and is our Sunday morning children's program run during the school term. The children leave after the children's talk to gather in their **Leopard and Lion age groups.** An enthusiastic group of volunteers lead these groups, teaching the children about God in a fun and friendly environment. The Scripture Union Light curriculum is used for KATS.

KATS will meet every Sunday in 2022.

Youth (Grades 6 - 12)

This year we are launching a new look youth group which will combine Junior and Senior Youth Groups and will meet every second Friday night in the Hall. We pray that it will be a great evening to hang out with friends and to spend some time asking the big questions of life and to pray and worship together.

We really love seeing our young people take part in worship on Sundays. We seek to support and encourage them to discover their leadership gifts and to be looking at ways to serve God in the Church and Community.

Children's & Youth Events

A number of events are run during the year, such as the Youth camp, the Moonwalk and the Light Party. Keep checking the newsletter and enews for updates about these events.

Safe Ministry with Children

TUC has adopted the Uniting Church in Australia Queensland Synod's Safe Ministry with Children policy and believes that every person is precious to God and in following Jesus' example, we are committed to providing a safe church for all, particularly those who are vulnerable.

Resources for Families


I imagine your children, like mine, have lots of questions.
