Minister's Letter: WELCOME!

Is there an old photo of yourself, perhaps sun-faded by the years, which captures a sense of independence and freedom you had at that time? Possibly before the demands of responsibility enfolded you, when you had time for travelling parts unknown?

We all want to live with freedom and follow our aspirations, unhindered by the constraints of everyday life. Personal freedom rates near the top in most people's values. A person's freedom to choose their future is considered essential to form their identity and autonomy. (Try making a list of popular songs that take freedom as an anthem, it's our modern mantra.)

Do you remember watching (if you're old enough – it was 1989!) live news reports of East and West Germans freely crossing the boarder, and their elation to stand together on the Berlin Wall. Overnight, the ugly structure that had separated them for 28 years become obsolete.


The lead up to this momentous time included East German churches taking a key role in peaceful protest. Churches were instrumental to this path to freedom, as they were one of the few places where the communist state allowed freedom of assembly. Beginning in 1980, churches began praying weekly for the reunification of their country and initially, a handful of Christians, a few dozen at most, assembled. Gradually, though, the congregations for these prayer meetings began to swell, attracting not just believers but also political dissidents and ordinary citizens. After each meeting the groups would join together and walk through the dark streets of Leipzig, singing hymns and holding candles and banners—a most benign form of political protest. The protests grew to hundreds, then thousands, then 70,000! Why the military did not open fire on the protestors is still debated, but everyone credits the prayer vigils for offering peaceful protests that led to the dismantling of not just the Berlin wall, but the entire communist state.

As the hated wall began to be torn down, a huge banner appeared across a Leipzig strasse: Wir danken Dir, Kirche (We thank you, church).

Freedom certainly matters to us, and Jesus promised us his truth will set you free. "If the Son sets you free, you will be free indeed." (John 8: 36) Let's experience that as our life story and dig into that promise over November.

Our congregational meeting is Sunday 20th November, and an opportunity to hear some of the recent developments and opportunities for mission and outreach to Toowong. Please do bring your ideas and questions, if you can make it.








We are collating creative artworks and we are seeking involvement from the hidden artists in the congregation!
