If you've ever been through any kind of major project, you'll know that special brand of anxiety


when you begin to doubt your capacity and wonder "have I bitten off more than I can chew?" This month we look at the prophet Zechariah, who found the people in his own day giving over to self doubt and despair, when they attempted to rebuild the ruined temple. Daunted by the scope of work to be done and their own flagging energy reserves, they decided to quit the project. Then God gave a series of visions to Zechariah and this awe- inducing word – "not by might, nor by power, but by my Spirit, says the Lord" (Zechariah 4: 6)

Our theme of Rebuilders is looking at the call on our lives to participate in God's vision for communities and cities of Kingdom life where the justice and graciousness of God's heart becomes real and visible through all the senses, especially through our interior, spiritual life. The scale of God's vision should produce a daunting feeling of being called into a project too big for us to cope with. Good news everyone, its only ever possible through the Spirit at work in us.

So, grab your trowel and hammer, it's our calling to cooperate with what God is doing all around us.






Our church will join thousands of other churches across Australia in this survey, to listen, reflect and act for the future.


What happens at Children's Ministry?

- Children are encouraged to get to know God and to talk to Him
- Children grow in confidence to read and learn about God's word for themselves
- To help them do this, high-quality, approved, curriculum-based material has been chosen
- Teachers are passionate about sharing God's love with young people in a caring and supportive environment
- Children learn in a creative, thoughtful and play-based session

How can you as a parent or carer, help your child enjoy this time?

- Come as often as you can so that your child has continuity, knows what to expect and most important of all can make great friends!
- Ask them about what they learn and what they have experienced
- Lean on God to help you:
 - Talk to God together A suggestion would be to pray with your child at bedtime after their bedtime story.
 - Celebrate Enjoy time together and thank God for it.
 - Read the Bible together read a Children's Bible story each night as part of the night time routine or together as a family.
 - Grow with your children all these things are easier
 when your child is small but I urge you to continue
 these things throughout their lives; see them as not
 just a child's routine but as your routine. Your
 children will learn from you, as they mature into
 teenage and then adulthood, that friendship with
 God is a lifelong adventure.
