

### An eight week journey through the Lord's Prayer

Started on 23 August in small groups www.prayercourse.org

Some of our groups have just completed The Prayer Course at TUC! This eight week course is run by the 24-7 Prayer group, and you can find all the resources you will need to run the course in your small group on the website above.

That's right, instead of just running this course from one location at TUC, we are asking you to start up small groups in your homes and lead the course yourselves. We think this will be a great opportunity to all be working through this course together as we grow deeper in our praying relationship with God and strengthen relationships with one another.

#### Here's what to do:

### 1. Let us know if you would like to lead a small group.

You can invite whoever you like to your group, and keep it as big or small as you like. Why not even invite friends and family from outside TUC to come along? You can choose when you meet with your group over the 8 weeks e.g. maybe every Sunday afternoon, or maybe on a weeknight, whatever suits you and your group best. You could choose to meet always in your home, or in a different home each time. You could also run each week's session on Zoom. Each session goes for an hour, and the website has all the videos, discussion questions and ideas for how to run each session - just follow along.

### 2. Let us know if you would like to be placed with a group.

We will get in touch with the group leaders and help connect you with a group.

### Welcome!

Have you ever asked yourself the question "what is my salvation for?" Obviously we have received the Great Exchange of our disobedience and sin for salvation in Christ and eternal life in the kingdom. So every Monday morning, as our feet hit the floor, ask ourself again just what it is that my salvation is working out in God's kingdom. How is my personal redemption forming the life of Christ in my street.

Jesus told his disciples that he is "the living bread, which is my flesh, which I will give for the life of the world." When you and I catch the significance of this, as we are incorporated into the Body of Christ, we become 'the Body' brought together for the life of the world, for the flourishing of all creation. What does flourishing life in the Kingdom look like from your front door? Where should that vision come from in your life?

Rainer Rilke was an Austrian poet (1875 – 1926) who after visiting Russia, and being inspired by the lives of faith he encountered there, wrote a book of poetry he called love poems to God. His poem 'The Limits of Your Longing" might speak to your desire to allow Christ to embody you.

God speaks to each of us as He makes us. Then walks with us silently out of the night. These are the words we dimly hear. You, sent out beyond your recall Go to the limits of your longing. Embody me. Flare up like flame And make big shadows I can move in. Let everything happen to you: beauty and terror. Just keep going, no feeling is final. Don't let yourself lose me. Nearby is the country they call life. You will know it by its seriousness. Give me your hand.



### Children's & Youth Ministry

#### **KATS (Toddlers - Year 5)**

KATS stands for Kids at Toowong on Sunday and is our Sunday morning children's program run during the school term. The children leave after the children's talk to gather in their **Tiger, Leopard and Lion age groups.** An enthusiastic group of volunteers lead these groups, teaching the children about God in a fun and friendly environment.

### Junior Youth (years 6 - 8)

Junior Youth also gather on Sunday mornings after the children's talk for a time of bible study and fun activities. The Scripture Union Light curriculum is used for KATS and Junior Youth. Each session encourages the children to get to know God better through praying together, looking at the bible together and themed games and craft.

### Senior Youth (years 9 - 12)

Senior Youth join in with the whole Sunday worship and are encouraged to take on leadership roles in the church. Senior Youth also meet together every second Friday night during the school term for Youth Group.

#### Children's & Youth Events
