We are excited to have launched The Prayer Course at TUC! This eight week course is run by the 24-7 Prayer group, and you can find all the resources you will need to run the course in your small group on the website above.

That's right, instead of just running this course from one location at TUC, we are asking you to start up small groups in your homes and lead the course yourselves. We think this will be a great opportunity to all be working through this course together as we grow deeper in our praying relationship with God and strengthen relationships with one another.

Here's what to do:

You can invite whoever you like to your group, and keep it as big or small as you like. Why not even invite friends and family from outside TUC to come along? Each session goes for an hour, and the website has all the videos, discussion questions and ideas for how to run each session - just follow along.

"I am the way, and the truth, and the life; no one comes to the Father but through Me." —Jesus

Who loves going on a big holiday trip? There's excitement when preparing for an adventure and exploring new horizons, especially when you first leave the driveway and everyone is buzzing. How does it feel 6, 12, 24 hours later? It can be tough, but at that point, well on your way, that long, sometime difficult journey offers up the possibility for personal transformation.

In the early church, believers were referred to as "followers of the Way." Paul recalls in Acts 22: 4 how he imprisoned without mercy "those of the Way." What is this way all about? What does it mean to be a follower of the way? Before Christianity was understood as a religion, it was instead known as a distinctive way of life. It's not so much that Christians are people who believe certain things, but that they are people who live a certain way.

Pilgrims throughout the centuries have walked on sacred tracks, notably Jerusalem as the final destination, or equally renown, El Camino (The Way

of St James) a network of pilgrim trails that lead to Spain's De Compostela church. These pilgrimages in times past required years of dedicated walking, navigating across seas and mountains, and still take many months to traverse today. People dedicated their walking as an act of devotion and worship to God, and we continue to find this thoughtful act of living on the trail deeply transformative.

In the many journeys you make in life, that shape you and refine your character, the path you take and the time it takes to get where you're going, is just as important as the destinations you choose (you know this.) As a Christ -community, we share the amazing task of recognising the call of God's Spirit on us, to follow Jesus, to continue on the Way. We do this best when we journey with spiritual companions like you.



Children's & Youth Ministry

KATS (Toddlers - Year 5)

KATS stands for Kids at Toowong on Sunday and is our Sunday morning children's program run during the school term. The children leave after the children's talk to gather in their **Tiger, Leopard and Lion age groups.** An enthusiastic group of volunteers lead these groups, teaching the children about God in a fun and friendly environment.

Junior Youth (years 6 - 8)

Junior Youth also gather on Sunday mornings after the children's talk for a time of bible study and fun activities. The Scripture Union Light curriculum is used for KATS and Junior Youth. Each session encourages the children to get to know God better through praying together, looking at the bible together and themed games and craft.

Senior Youth (years 9 - 12)

Senior Youth join in with the whole Sunday worship and are encouraged to take on leadership roles in the church. Senior Youth also meet together every second Friday night during the school term for Youth Group.

Children's & Youth Events

A number of events are run during the year, such as the Junior Youth Sleepover, the Moonwalk and the Light Party. Keep checking the newsletter and enews for updates about these events.
