Welcome!

As a child, I consumed American TV and movies voraciously, fascinated by this shiny world where people wore high-top sneakers, ate cookies and went to prom. A lot of the time, the protagonists in these films were driven by a desire to throw off the stifling expectations of their parents - nay, the world - and pursue their dream job; that one vital thing that they were meant to do that would give their life true meaning and purpose. It usually involved becoming a dancer.

While these cheesy movies of my childhood would wrap up in about 90 minutes with the hero achieving their dream, the pursuit of a dream job is not such an easy task in reality. Not everyone has the luxury to think about the kind of work or life they would like to have. And even the best job, a job that lines up with one's skills and passions, has undesirable aspects. So what do we do when our work (paid or otherwise) doesn't live up to our expectations and we are still left searching for meaning and purpose?

Jesus said "on this rock I will build my church, and the gates of Hades will not overcome it." (Matthew 16:18). The word "ecclesia" is used in place of "church" in the original Greek and means "a people called together for a purpose". What purpose? Not simply to gather together once a week to sing a few songs and hear a sermon, but rather to know the amazing truth of who Christ is and how he has saved us, and to go and share this with the whole world so everyone can know that they are included in God's family.

We often hear stories of people being called to live out this purpose in exciting ways; they get to go to exotic locations where no one has heard of God before to preach the Good News and receive converts. It's easy to listen to stories like this and think "well, what good am I doing here in Brisbane working as a...".

Of course God calls people to be part of these big and exciting things, but He also calls us to be present in the small, everyday things. What's most important is that we are all included in His purpose. Plus, I'm not even sure God sees things in terms of "big" or "small"... that kind of hierarchy seems to be something we are very good at creating and enforcing, but doesn't really fit with who God is.

The apostle Paul writes "whatever you do, whether in word or deed, do it all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through him." (Colossians 3:17).

Whatever you do.

Our identity is first and foremost in Christ, not in our careers or anything else. However, the work we do does give us unique opportunities to be taking the gospel message into the community. Where do you find yourself right now? Even if you do not have paid employment, where do you spend most of your time and who are the people around you? How can you be light and salt in those places, showing the love of Christ to all? Our prayer as Christ's ecclesia here in Toowong is that we can encourage and equip each other to take the love of Christ with us as we go out into our weeks.

Let's bloom with the Spirit's power wherever we find ourselves, like trees planted by streams of water, yielding fruit for the glory of God.

Children's & Youth Ministry

KATS (Toddlers - Year 5)

KATS stands for Kids at Toowong on Sunday and is our Sunday morning children's program run during the school term. The children leave after the children's talk to gather in their **Tiger, Leopard and Lion age groups.** An enthusiastic group of volunteers lead these groups, teaching the children about God in a fun and friendly environment.

Junior Youth (years 6 - 8)

Junior Youth also gather on Sunday mornings after the children's talk in the church house for a time of bible study and fun activities. The Scripture Union Light curriculum is used for KATS and Junior Youth. Each session encourages the children to get to know God better through praying together, looking at the bible together and themed games and craft.

Senior Youth (years 9 - 12)

Senior Youth join in with the whole Sunday worship and are encouraged to take on leadership roles in the church. Senior Youth also meet together every second Saturday night during the school term for Youth Group. Our remaining dates for Senior Youth in term 2 are: 11 May, 25 May, 8 June and 22 June.

Children's & Youth Events
